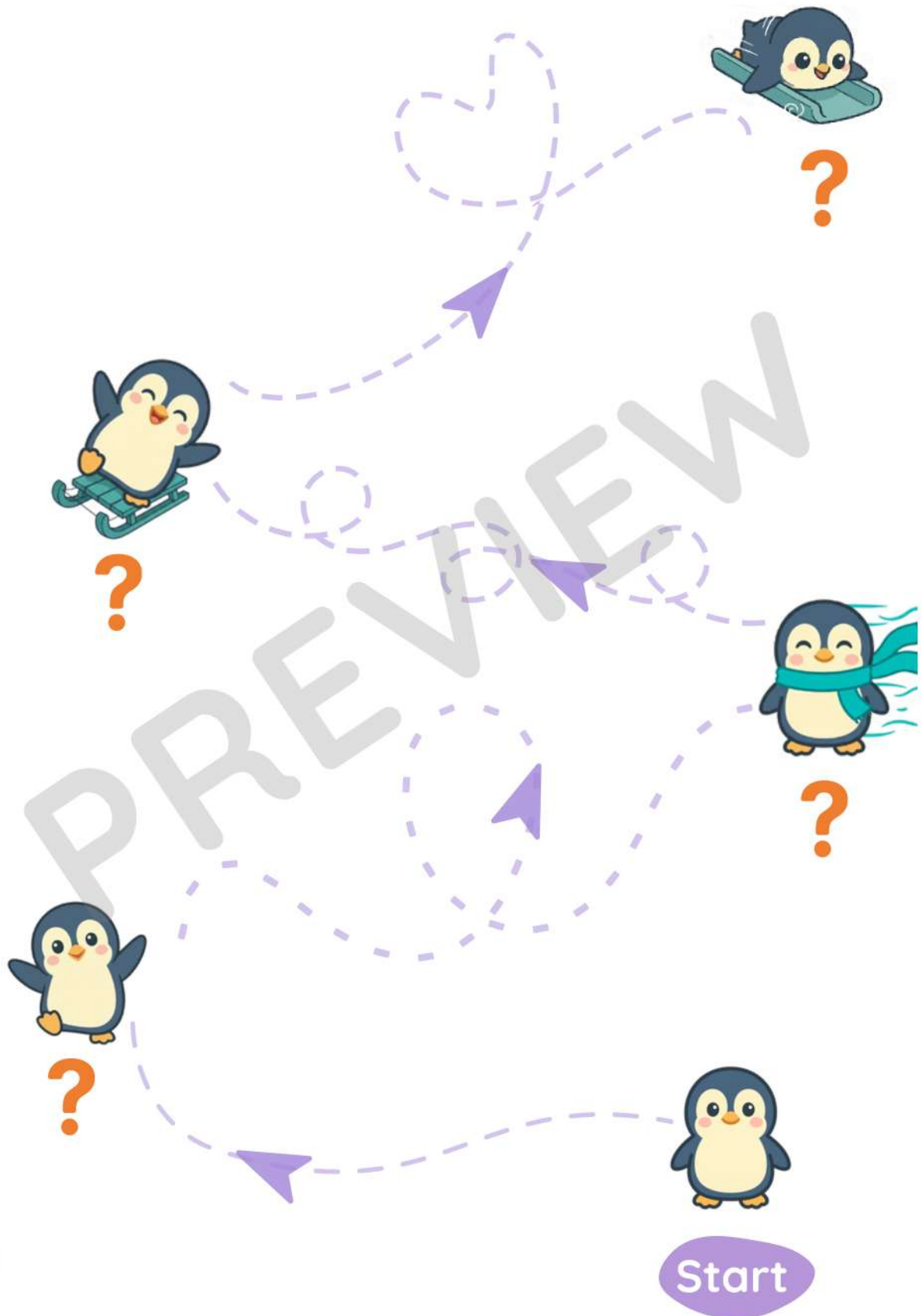


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PARENT GUIDE

Before You Begin

- This workbook is designed to build confidence first, not perfection
- Your child does not need neat lines or perfect grip to succeed
- If your child enjoys scribbling or following paths with a finger, they are ready

Practice Frequency & Routine

- Short, happy practice sessions work best:
 - 2-3 pages per day
 - 3-4 days a week
 - Always stop before frustration
- Consistency matters more than speed
- You may print and reuse pages as often as needed

How to Introduce a Worksheet

- Sit beside your child
- Trace once together using a finger
- Use simple instructions
- Allow independent attempts
- Avoid erasing or fixing lines. Learning happens through movement

Beginner: Basic Line Strokes

Purpose?

- Builds hand stability, wrist control and directional awareness
- Helps write half the capital letters (E, F, H, I, L, T) and numbers like 1, 4, 7
- Child develops confidence in holding writing tools

Pencil grip tip

Focus on using the large arm muscles; introduce the grasp concept gently using a short pencil or crayon

Guidance

- Let your child enjoy the movement first
- Praise effort, not neatness
- If your child switches hands or lifts the pencil often, that's normal — they are still exploring muscle control!

Complimentary fine motor activity for the child

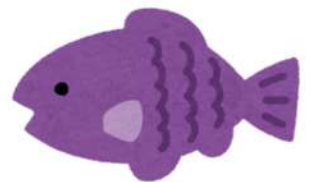
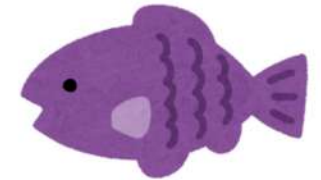
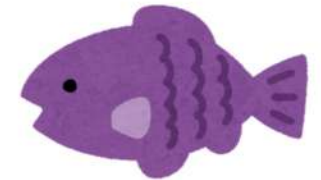
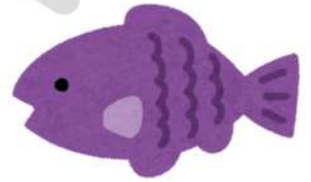
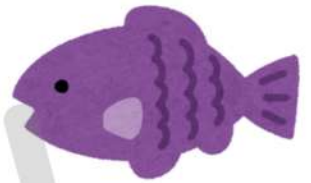
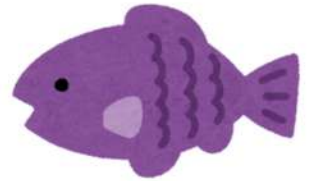
Practice picking up small objects with child-sized tongs to strengthen the pincer grasp

When can I move to the next stage?

Your child can trace straight lines with control and follow the direction of the path

Horizontal Line Tracing

Intermediate: Angles and Directions

- Wide zig zag line tracing
- Tight zig zag line tracing
- Zig zag upward line tracing
- Zig zag downward line tracing
- Zig zag modified line tracing

Help Waddle climb on the snowy hills!



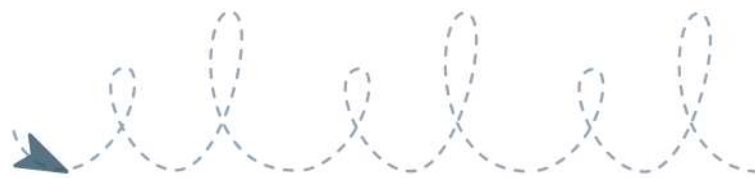
